Naukati Bay Resolution B-05

Whereas, Naukati Bay Inc., has been participating, contributing, and reporting on the Prince of Wales Island wide Borough Study since first initiated by a grant from the Prince of Wales Commerce Advisory Committee (POWCAC) with the consultants Sheinberg Associates in 2011; and once presented with the alternatives and recommendations from the consultants; held an informational meeting July 17, 2013, and on July 20, 2013 voted for the Home Rule Borough with Land Selection Option A, B, C; and

Whereas POWCAC recommended a committee form to review the State of Alaska Home Rule charters and create a draft POW Island Borough Charter over 2014; and a draft was presented for review; and

Whereas, September 19, 2015 an informational meeting was held to review the draft charter with the chair of the Committee and POWCAC Jon Boiling, On November 16, 2015 the membership met to review and discusses the draft borough charter and voted to support the draft charter.

Therefore, Naukati Bay Inc., supports the POWCAC Draft POW Island Draft Borough Charter, understanding that voting to approve the draft charter does not imply that POWCAC is ready or will move forward with forming a borough, and that a separate individual vote would occur island wide to determine and decide if forming a borough should occur using this Charter to form.
